Holiday Programme:

Day 1 – Fly to Catania, on arrival you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel in Marina D'Agro, the Hotel Baia Taormina, just 45 minutes from the airport.

Day 2 – Free day in resort.

Day 3 – Mount Etna experience - After breakfast, you will set out to experience one of the island's most extraordinary natural wonders: majestic Mt. Etna. With more than 400 craters scattered across its vast landscape, Etna stands as Europe's largest and most persistently active volcano, a giant that never truly sleeps. For those who wish to, there is the opportunity to ascend to an elevation of 1,900 meters above sea level, where the air grows crisp and the views expand into sweeping, unforgettable panoramas that stretch from rugged lava fields to the distant coastline. After our visit, we return to Taormina, allowing some free time to stroll its charming streets, relax, or simply soak in the town's iconic beauty, before returning back the hotel for the evening.

*For those who wish to take a cable car / 4x4 to the top of Mount Etna, this can be arranged on the day. Exact cost is unknown, however based on this year's prices it will be approximately 65 euro per person to go from Funivia – 2500m. Further information will be sent out with your joining instructions.

Day 4 – Free day in resort.
